Hello Central Families,

I am happy to welcome all of you to Central High School for the 2022-2023 school year. We are excited about the return of all of our students and are looking forward to partnering with our families to make this year a success.

In 2022-23, we will continue to increase our emphasis on the following:

- Ensuring the health and safety of our students and staff
- Focusing on providing all students with the proper social, emotional, and mental health supports
- Communicating and implementing the CHS Vision of the Graduate
- Promoting regular School Attendance
- Implementing consistent Curriculum and Instruction focused on student-centered learning across all subjects and grade levels
- Connecting with our Families and Community Partners

Our first day of school for all students is Monday, August 29th. All students are expected to be in their first period class by 7:43 am every day. Students should access their class schedule through the PowerSchool Portal prior to coming on Monday. No paper copies of schedules will be distributed.

Please note the following important items:

- Students who would like to request a schedule change should email or message their counselor on Teams. Student schedules will only be changed if the student has previously taken a core class they are scheduled in or need a course added for graduation this year. If a student needs a change for either of those reasons, they should contact their counselor. Students must follow their schedule in PowerSchool until they are informed of any changes.
- Any 12th grade students who are eligible for and interested in potentially graduating after Semester 1 should contact their counselor as soon as possible regarding this option.
- Attendance will be taken for all students on a daily basis in each class.
- The doors to the building will open at 7:10 am. Upon arrival to school:
 - 9th and 10th grade students will enter through the Front Main Lobby.
 - 11th and 12th grade students will enter through the Gym Lobby until 7:40 am.
 - All students arriving after 7:40 am will need to use the front entrance.
- Upon entry to the building, students will report directly to their period 1 class.
- Students will not be allowed to congregate in common areas and must report directly to their classroom or to the F-105 cafeteria for breakfast.

- Breakfast is available in the F-105 cafeteria until 7:40 am.
- Aquaculture students should receive a ride directly to the Aquaculture School or pick up the bus from Central in front of the Gym Lobby no later than 7:40 am.
- RCA students will have access to a bus from Central at 12:58 pm Monday through Thursday.
