- **Collaboration with a team of experts to determine which practice yields positive student results and accelerates student learning**



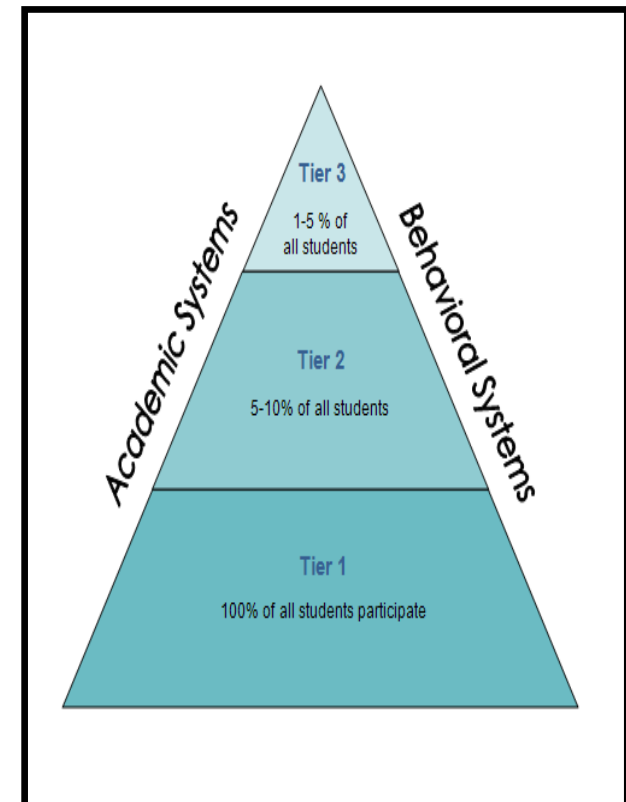

## WHAT IS SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH- BASED INTERVENTION? (SRBI)



Our administrator, support staff, and teachers are committed to using all means necessary to assist each of our students in obtaining their full potential.

SRBI intervention includes:

- Universal SRBI instruction in the classroom for 30 minutes daily:
  - Guided reading groups
  - Literacy circles
  - Small group instruction in Math and Literacy skills
  - Use of technology to support the mastering of Math and Literacy Common Core State Standards
- I-Ready benchmark assessments three times yearly to assess progress towards achievement of grade level Math/Literacy skills
- Referral to SRBI team as a proactive strategy when necessary to provide:
  - Small group instruction with interventionists to fill gaps in achievement
  - Ongoing progress monitoring

- to ensure effectiveness of instruction
- SRBI data is reviewed on a monthly basis to assess continued need for targeted tiered instruction

### SRBI Tiers

Tier 1: Universal Level (all students are part of Tier 1).

Tier 2: Students requiring remediation in specific curriculum subjects or in the area of social/emotional learning to achieve grade level standards.

Tier 3: Students requiring intensive remediation in one or more curriculum subjects or in the area of social/emotional learning to achieve grade standards.
