## Grades 3 to High School Khan Academy Get Ready for Grade Level

- 2. Sign up for an account or log in to an existing account and begin the course for the grade level for next school year.
- 3. Practice math every day to keep your skills sharp.
- 4. When summer ends, record the number of missions you completed on Khan Academy on the log.
