2024-2025 Expectations:

- Students must have student IDs to enter the building and IDs must be worn for the entire school day. Returning students must bring the ID that was given to them last school year, replacement IDs are \$5. If your child forgets their ID, they will receive a pass for the day. After two occasions without school ID, student will have ISS.
- Doors for school entry close at 9:00 AM for students with a full schedule and 10:00 AM for students who do not have a first period class, students who arrive after doors close must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Students with doctor's notes or mandatory court appointments can arrive to school after doors close with appropriate documentation.

- Students should never open any doors in the building to allow anyone to enter. All guest and students must enter through door 2 for security purposes.
- No ski-mask should be brought in the building.
- During lunch students are expected to remain in the cafeteria for the duration of their lunch period.
- Loitering in any part of the building can lead to disciplinary actions.
