MINUTES OF THE (SECOND) SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BRIDGEPORT BOARD OF EDUCATION, held November 12, 2019, at Geraldine Johnson School, 475 Lexington Avenue, Bridgeport, Connecticut.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were Chair John Weldon, Vice Chair Jessica Martinez Secretary Joseph Sokolovic, Hernan Illingworth, Sybil Allen, Maria Pereira, LaMar Kennedy, and Joseph Lombard.
