| 1  | (The meeting was called to order at 6:08 p.m.)                                |
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| 2  | MAYOR GANIM: Okay. Well, let me – at least my part here is – is               |
| 3  | usually brief, but it's a - not only an annual tradition, but it's            |
| 4  | organizationally, I think, a great way to proceed, so my pleasure again to    |
| 5  | join you for this – it's the first annual Organizational Meeting of the       |
| 6  | Board of Education, being held today, Monday, December 6th, 2021,             |
| 7  | now at 6:00 p.m., here at the Aquaculture School.                             |
| 8  | So the agenda, which is rather simple, call to order, which we're             |
| 9  | doing right now. Call to order. And then just opening up with the election    |
| 10 | of the officers.  |
| 11 | So unless there's any order of business that needs to proceed                 |
| 12 | that, I'm going to go with the agenda. And we'll start with the first order   |
| 13 | of business, which is the election of the officers. And so with that, at this |
| 14 | time I'll open up the floor to nominations for chairman. Nominations for      |
| 15 | chairman. Anyone.   |
| 16 | No nominations. Nominations are closed. No, I'm just kidding.                 |
| 17 | MR. LOMBARD: Hello there.   |
| 18 | MS. BROWN: We can hear you.   |
| 19 | MR. BENEJAN: We can hear you.   |
| 20 | SUPT. TESTANI: Go ahead, Mr. Lombard.   |
| 21 | MR. LOMBARD: I'm going to nominate John Weldon.                               |
| 22 | MS. ALLEN: I second.  |
| 23 | MAYOR GANIM: Okay. There's been a nomination; is there a                      |
| 24 | second?   |
| 25 | MS. ALLEN: Second.  |

| 1  | MAYOR GANIM: Okay. So you go with a nomination and a                     |
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| 2  | second, right? Okay, fine.   |
| 3  | Any other nominations? John Weldon's name is in nomination.              |
| 4  | Any other nominations?   |
| 5  | Hearing none, we'll close nominations –                                  |
| 6  | MS. CASTILLO: Nomination.  |
| 7  | MAYOR GANIM: Sorry?  |
| 8  | MS. CASTILLO: Nomination for -   |
| 9  | MAYOR GANIM: Do you want to make a -                                     |
| 10 | MS. CASTILLO: - Christine Baptiste-Perez.                                |
| 11 | MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: I second.  |
| 12 | MAYOR GANIM: Okay. Nomination of Christine and seconded. So              |
| 13 | are there - so you're - as well. Anyone else?                            |
| 14 | All right. At this time nominations are closed and we'll ask for you     |
| 15 | to take the normal practice to select from the two candidates which have |
| 16 | been nominated, which is paper ballot, I remember from last year.        |
| 17 | (There was a delay.)   |
| 18 | MAYOR GANIM: So - did everybody vote? It looks like everyone's           |
| 19 | all set. I'm sorry, yes. Yes.  |
| 20 | Seven? John Weldon, seven; two, Christine Baptiste. So seven to          |
| 21 | two, John Weldon is the chair of the Board of Education. Welcome back    |
| 22 | again.   |
| 23 | MR. WELDON: Thank you.   |
| 24 | MAYOR GANIM: That's it, right, for me? Well, thank you. I want           |
| 25 | to hand the chair over to you with the hammer and everything, and get    |

| 1  | out of the way before you get the hammer. And thank you, everyone,        |

| 2  | again, and going to go on to board of ed. Supe, thank you so much, and    |
| 3  | thanks for – here.  |
| 4  | MR. WELDON: Okay. Thank you, Mayor. Next, I will seek                     |
| 5  | nominations for the office of vice chair. Is there a nomination for vice? |
| 6  | MR. BENEJAN: I have a nomination, Mr. Chair.                              |
| 7  | MR. WELDON: Okay.   |
| 8  | MR. BENEJAN: I'd like to nominate Ms. Bobbi Brown as the vice             |
| 9  | chair.  |
| 10 | MR. SOKOLOVIC: I'll second.   |
| 11 | MR. WELDON: Okay. Mr. Benejan nominates Bobbi Brown and                   |
| 12 | Mr. Sokolovic seconds.  |
| 13 | Are there any other nominations?  |
| 14 | MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: I nominate Mike Maccarone.                            |
| 15 | MR. WELDON: Okay. Mike Maccarone from Christine Baptiste-                 |
| 16 | Perez. Is there a second?   |
| 17 | MS. CASTILLO: I will second.  |
| 18 | MR. WELDON: Okay. Are there any other nominations?                        |
| 19 | MS. ALLEN: I'd like to nominate Mr. Sokolovic.                            |
| 20 | MR. SOKOLOVIC: I'm going to decline. Thank you very much, Ms              |
| 21 | Allen. I appreciate the thought.  |
| 22 | MR. WELDON: Mr. Sokolovic declines. Okay. Are there any other             |
| 23 | nominations?  |
| 24 | I will nominate our current - I'm sorry - yeah, Bobbi Brown.              |
| 25 | Okay. So are there any other nominations? Any other                       |

| 1  | nominations? Third and final call: Any other nominations? Nominations |

| 2  | are closed.   |
| 3  | So the two choices are Bobbi Brown and Michael Maccarone.             |
| 4  | (There was a delay.)  |
| 5  | MR. WELDON: Okay. Seven ballots for Bobbi Brown; two for              |
| 6  | Michael Maccarone.  |
| 7  | Next, call for nominations for the office of secretary. Are there any |
| 8  | nominations?  |
| 9  | MR. SOKOLOVIC: Mr. Chair, I'd like to nominate Albert Benejan.        |
| 10 | MR. WELDON: Is there a second?  |
| 11 | MS. ALLEN: I'll second it.  |
| 12 | MR. WELDON: Okay. Are there any further nominations? Are              |
| 13 | there any further nominations?  |
| 14 | MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: I nominate Joseph Lombard.                        |
| 15 | MR. WELDON: That was Christine?                                       |
| 16 | MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: Yes.  |
| 17 | MS. CASTILLO: I second it.  |
| 18 | MR. WELDON: Okay. Mr. Lombard. Are there any further                  |
| 19 | nominations? Are there any further nominations? Third and final call: |
| 20 | Are there any nominations?  |
| 21 | The nominations are closed. Ms. Valle, will you pass out the          |
| 22 | ballots. The two candidates are Albert Benejan and Joseph Lombard.    |
| 23 | (There was a delay.)  |
| 24 | MR. WELDON: Five votes for Joseph Lombard; four for Albert            |
| 25 | Benejan. Mr. Lombard prevails.  |

| 1  | Next on the agenda is approval of 2020 Organizational Meeting           |
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| 2  | minutes. Is there a motion to approve the org meeting minutes from one  |
| 3  | year ago?   |
| 4  | MS. BROWN: So moved.  |
| 5  | MS. ALLEN: Second.  |
| 6  | MR. WELDON: Moved by Ms. Brown; seconded by Ms. Allen. Is               |
| 7  | there any discussion?   |
| 8  | All in favor?   |
| 9  | ("Ayes" were sounded.)  |
| 10 | MR. WELDON: Any opposed? Who said opposed?                              |
| 11 | MS. BROWN: Behind you.  |
| 12 | MR. BENEJAN: Behind you.  |
| 13 | MR. WELDON: Mr. Lombard is opposed?                                     |
| 14 | MR. LOMBARD: No, I think it's delayed in time.                          |
| 15 | MR. WELDON: Okay. Any abstentions?                                      |
| 16 | MR. SOKOLOVIC: There should be three.                                   |
| 17 | MR. WELDON: The motion carries; the minutes are approved.               |
| 18 | Last is approval of calendar year 2022 schedule of regular public       |
| 19 | meetings. It's the last page of the packet.                             |
| 20 | This is based on a schedule of our meeting on the second and            |
| 21 | fourth Mondays of the month, every month, except in June, which we will |
| 22 | meet only once because school ends on June 14th and we do not meet      |
| 23 | when school is not in session. And then we resume meeting on the        |
| 24 | fourth Monday in August, when school will begin to be in session, and   |
| 25 | continue on through December.   |

| 1  | Are there any anomalies, Ms. Valle? You prepared this; are there           |

| 2  | any anomalies you want to point out, like something that was moved         |
| 3  | from a Monday to a Tuesday because of the holiday or anything?             |
| 4  | I see we have a couple of Tuesdays. Tuesday, September 27th,               |
| 5  | that was moved for -   |
| 6  | MS. VALLE: A Jewish holiday.   |
| 7  | MR. WELDON: - a Jewish holiday, and October 11th. We're off                |
| 8  | on that Monday. Okay.  |
| 9  | Are there any questions?   |
| 10 | MR. SOKOLOVIC: I'd like to make a motion to amend. I don't                 |
| 11 | know how – how everybody feels about coming to a meeting on                |
| 12 | Valentine's Day, February 14th. If we could amend it to the 15th.          |
| 13 | MS. BROWN: Can I second.   |
| 14 | MR. LOMBARD: Can I ask that microphones are turned on.                     |
| 15 | MS. BROWN: Turn your mike on.  |
| 16 | MR. SOKOLOVIC: Yes. I apologize, Mr. Lombard. I made an                    |
| 17 | amendment to change February 14th to February 15th because that's          |
| 18 | Valentine's Day, and a lot of people might have other things to do. And i  |
| 19 | was seconded – and it was seconded by Ms. Brown.                           |
| 20 | MS. BROWN: Yeah, I second the amendment.                                   |
| 21 | MR. WELDON: Okay. All those in favor of amending the schedule              |
| 22 | as noted by Mr. Sokolovic, signify by saying aye.                          |
| 23 | ("Ayes" were sounded.)   |
| 24 | MR. WELDON: Any opposed? Any abstentions? So the schedule                  |
| 25 | is amended that the first meeting in February will be on the 15th, not the |

| 1  | 14th. So now that the schedule's been modified in that regard, is there a |
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| 2  | motion to approve it as amended?  |
| 3  | MR. SOKOLOVIC: So moved.  |
| 4  | MS. ALLEN: So moved.  |
| 5  | MS. BROWN: Second.  |
| 6  | MR. WELDON: Moved by Mr. Sokolovic; seconded by Ms. Brown.                |
| 7  | Any further discussion? All in favor?                                     |
| 8  | ("Ayes" were sounded.)  |
| 9  | Any opposed? Any opposed? Any abstentions? And, Ms. Valle,                |
| 10 | you have the correction. Thank you.                                       |
| 11 | I'll next seek a motion to adjourn.                                       |
| 12 | MS. BROWN: So moved.  |
| 13 | MS. ALLEN: Second.  |
| 14 | MR. BENEJAN: Second.  |
| 15 | MR. WELDON: Moved by Ms. Brown; seconded by Ms. Allen?                    |
| 16 | All in favor?   |
| 17 | Any opposed?  |
| 18 | ("Ayes" were sounded.)  |
| 19 | MR. WELDON: The time is noted as being 6:24 p.m.                          |
| 20 | (The meeting was adjourned at 6:24 p.m.)                                  |
