This exciting program will accept ten current Bridgeport teachers who are interested in serving the Bridgeport student community in a different way.

Particulars

Selected candidates will participate in the Alternative Route Certification program through CREC over the course of the Summer and during next school year. During this time, they will teach in special education classes in Bridgeport Public Schools under a durational shortage area permit.

Bridgeport Public Schools will pay for the cost of the cross endorsement program and provide an appreciation benefit for candidates who are willing to work in these high need positions. Candidates are committed to remain in Bridgeport Public Schools special education classrooms for a minimum of three years after the completion of the cross endorsement.
