Harding High School provides students, upon completion of freshman year, the opportunity to select a concentration in an area of their choice. The pathways available specialize in career-oriented topics: Health/Medical; Law/Public Service; or FAME – Fine Arts, Media, and Entertainment.

Success within each Pathway allows for more challenging course selections as the student matures. These educational incentives increase to advanced level curriculum, including UCONN ECE, AP Classes, Level 2, and Level 3 pathway options.
