WHAT IS INSTITUTIONAL AID?

Institutional Aid is money that comes from your college or university to help you pay tuition. This aid is awarded on the basis of your and your family's financial need. This is a grant- you do NOT need to pay the money back.



DO I QUALIFY? To Qualify You Need to:

- Have attended a CT high school for 2 years
- Have graduated from a CT High School or have received your GED
- Have come to the US before age 17
- Demonstrate financial need
- Have no felony convictions

Deadlines for Fall 2021- Spring 2022 school year

CT State Universities & Community Colleges:

HOW: Paper application called the AACTUS, Get it online or email your college financial aid office.

Community Colleges: No
deadline, recommend
apply in Spring semester
