- Pants
 - o tan or navy
- Skirts, Jumpers or Skorts
 - Tan or navy
- Shoes or Sneakers must be worn
 - o no flip flops, sandals or slippers allowed
 - o boots may be worn if inclement weather
- Shirts and sweaters
 - white, navy, or dark green
 - o collared polo shirts, dress shirts, long or short sleeve
- Physical Education Day
 - o must wear sneakers
 - may wear gray, black or navy sweatpants
 - Marin t-shirt
 - \circ white or blue t-shirts without logo
 - o Student may opt to wear the school uniform on PE days

A uniform closet is maintained in the building for students who are out of uniform or need a uniform. Please contact the Main Office for information.

When a student fails to comply with the Uniform Policy, the following procedure will apply:

- First Offense verbal warning and notification to parent by teacher
- Second Offense Written warning and notification to parent by teacher forms in Main Office
- Third and subsequent teacher will notify Support Staff who will arrange a parent conference
- Students may not be excluded from class when out of uniform.
