(The meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m.)

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MAYOR GANIM: If you don't know me, I'm Mayor

Joseph Ganim, and by charter of the City of Bridgeport,

it's my pleasure and honor at the beginning of the

year, at the beginning of the term, to chair the

Organizational Meeting, this Organizational Meeting, of

the Bridgeport Board of Education. And it's my pleasure

to do so.

And my role is somewhat limited and procedural, but I like to claim it's important, nonetheless. It's the - it's really the one time at the beginning of the year that I get to join the Board of Ed, to say congratulations, I guess formally now, that they've been sworn in, new and existing members of the Board of Education, citywide elected officials, who are charged with the high duty, privilege, and honor of guiding our new superintendent as - as we welcome her. She's beyond the welcoming point; she's here and she's moving. But to recommit ourselves, I think collectively, I know as members of the board, as members of the school administration, as members of the city administration and I see councilman - Councilwoman Maria Valle here representing the City Council as well - to ensure that we do everything that we can to make Bridgeport schools the place of learning the best that we can for all of

1 our students.

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So, I'm happy to join tonight. So, the public 2 3 knows - and we kind of were just going over it informally - what - how this will go. If you have the 4 agenda in front of you, it's noticed as the Annual 5 Organization Meeting - and I'm reading from the - from 6 7 the notice. Meeting of the Board of Education, which will be held Monday, December 11th, 2023, at 6:00 p.m., 8 9 here at - here at Geraldine Johnson School, 475 10 Lexington Avenue, Bridgeport. Public viewing access to 11 the meeting will be made available through - and it 12 gives the public access, which I could read to you, but you can see it as well. It's www-dot-bridgeportedu-at 13 net, slash, stream. 14

And so, from there the agenda is fairly simple. It's - it begins with a call to order. So, accept this as the call to order. And it's my assumption, I think accurately, this meeting is being recorded at this time, and so we are on the record, and the meeting has begun. It's a little after 6:00 p.m.

And the call to order is - with the first order of business - or number two on the agenda - is the election of officers.

And so that will proceed in the following way. I will - the first position, which is chair or president

of the board, which I will call for an opening of the nominations, and any member of the board can nominate any member of the board. And we've in the past have held that you need a second to the nomination, and if that becomes a point of contention, we'll discuss it at that time. But at this point, accept that it seems to be the practice that I don't think will be problematic tonight, there will be a second for a nomination, even if there's only one nomination. And the nomination will remain open to see if there's a second or a third, or as many nominations, and then at some point I'll entertain a motion, with a second - entertain a motion to close nominations.

Either way, if there's only one nomination and it basically appears to be uncontested - if there's more than one, there will be paper ballots, which has been the practice for voting for the officers in the Board of Education in the City of Bridgeport, at least through my tenure. And they'll be handed out by the secretary - and if we need to officially nominate our secretary - say it again - Rita Valle. And my apologies for not knowing your name before that. Unless there's objection - is our - our secretary, or the secretary pro tem or whatever the appropriate term is, so that she can handle the ballots and take us through the

1 process.

The members of the board will fill out their ballots; they'll pass them back in. She will then proceed to open them and count them out loud here in everyone's presence, and the results will be what the results are, and we'll announce the election of the chair or the president.

And at that point, I will, along with others, welcome the chair to take over, and will cede my seat and allow that chair to run the rest of the meeting, and of course continue on with the second item, which will be the vice chair and secretary, and then other matters, including the approval of organizational minutes, that are on the agenda for tonight.

So, with that, unless there's any questions or points of order anyone wants to add anything, correct. I make mistakes; if I did something that doesn't seem comfortable or familiar to you, let me know.

Hearing none, let the record reflect that we're going to begin now with the election of officers, and I will open nominations for the position of chair or sometimes referred to as president of the Board of Education. I'll look to my left.

| 13 | MAYOR GANIM: There's a second with that |
| 14 | nomination. And then, Albert, did you have a |
| 15 | nomination? |
| 16 | MR. BENEJAN GRAJALES: Yes, I nominate Mr. Joe |
| 17 | Sokolovic to be the board chair. |
| 18 | MAYOR GANIM: So, Albert nominates Joe Sokolovic. |
| 19 | Is there a second to that nomination? |
| 20 | MR. TRABER: I second that. |
| 21 | MAYOR GANIM: Okay, So, we have two nominations |
| 22 | and two seconds. |

| 24 | placed or put into nomination at this time? Hearing |
| 25 | none, I will close nominations. |

We have two candidates; they've been nominated and seconded. And as our protocol and practice has been describe, Madam Secretary, would you at this time distribute the ballots.

I'll turn it over - I told you, I don't get to the hammer, but I'll just tap it lightly, and say thank you for all members of the board for your willingness and commitment to serve, and to work in partnership, certainly with the superintendent, with the City Council, and myself and members of the administration,
