1 (The meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m.)

2 MAYOR GANIM: So, we're going to start in just -3 we're going to acknowledge that there's a notice public notice - for today and it's addressed - what I'm 4 reading is the agenda. To board members: The annual 5 organizational meeting, which happens every year at 6 7 this time - not particularly on this day, but this Monday - and today it's being held December 12th, 2022, 8 9 at 6:00 p.m., here as usual at the Bridgeport Regional 10 Vocational Aquaculture Science and Technology Center, 11 on 60 - it is St. Stephens Street? Okay. 60 St. 12 Stephens Street, Bridgeport.

Public access to the meeting is made available – will be made by available by the link that's attached there. I know we have members of the board that are zoom - we'll call Zoomed in - which is actually Zoom, but are in attendance, but I'll leave the actual quorum in attendance for a minute.

And the agenda we're going to do is we will - we will take attendance - assuming we have a quorum, which I believe we do. We'll quickly call to order, and then there will be the election of the officers in the following order. Of chairman - or chairperson. There will be nominations and votes. Then there will be vice chair, nominations and votes, and secretary, nomination

1 and votes.

2 At some point along the way - and I've done it 3 both ways - I've turned it over to the chair sometimes after the appointment or election of the 4 chair - and then sometimes the chair will continue on 5 with the vice, and we can deal with that. But 6 7 certainly, at the end of that, then the chair would 8 take over, and the only other matter - I'll leave it up 9 to the board's discretion beyond that - but the only 10 other matter printed on the agenda is the approval of 11 the 2021 organizational meeting minutes. 12 So having said all that and being aware that there is public access, that it is on, that we have at least 13 14 two board members that are behind us but not physically 15 here, can we take the rollcall so that we can verify 16 there's a quorum. 17 MR. LOMBARD: Sybil Allen. 18 MS. ALLEN: Here. 19 MR. LOMBARD: Christine Baptiste-Perez. 20 MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: Present. 21 MR. LOMBARD: Albert Benejan. 22 MR. BENEJAN: Present. 23 MR. LOMBARD: Bobbi Brown. 24 MS. BROWN: Present. 25 MR. LOMBARD: Erika Castillo said she would not be

1 present. Joseph Lombard, present. 2 Michael Maccarone. MR. MACCARONE: Present. 3 MR. LOMBARD: Joseph Sokolovic. 4 MR. SOKOLOVIC: Present. 5 MR. LOMBARD: All right, that's it. We have a 6 7 quorum. 8 MAYOR GANIM: So, we have a quorum. It's my 9 understanding there's nine members, one is - there's

10 actually only eight members now because we have one 11 kind of temporary - or pending vacancy.

So, with that, there's a quorum, and as was mentioned, it's no secret, this is the organizational meeting and it's chaired by charter by me as mayor. And it's basically a process where at this time we'll open for the first order of business, which is the election of the officers.

18 And as indicated, the first officer to be elected 19 will be the chairman or the chairperson, and so at this 20 time - and again, before I open nominations, I can say 21 it now or we can do it after we open nominations, but 22 usually there will be a verbal nomination. I don't know 23 if we require a second or not. I usually like a second, 24 but, Mark, is it the board's practice that there's no 25 need for a second.

Well, why don't we do this. If there's going to be a problem with a second, we'll raise the issue. I don't know that there is or there isn't, but we'll deal with it at that point. And then - but there are going to be paper ballots for any names that go in - there will be ballot, voting by paper ballot is that the continue to be the practice?

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MS. BROWN: Yes.

9 MAYOR GANIM: Because you've upgraded some
 10 technology since I was here last time, which is good.

MS. BROWN: The board members online can do via
Teams.

13 MAYOR GANIM: And so - and is that a practice - I 14 don't know - but that the board members that are online 15 - and because this part of it is new to me, I'll hear 16 from any board member - is it they will vote online by 17 what mechanism? It's called Team? So, they will be 18 able to log their vote in - and I don't know whether 19 it's visible or not, but as long as everyone's 20 comfortable with that process - and unless somebody 21 from the - from the - one of the members tells me that 22 they're not - I'm going to continue talk slowly, and 23 assume that everybody's on board for that -24 MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: Mr. Mayor.

25 MAYOR GANIM: Yes.

MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: Last year, when we did the organizational meeting, we had nominations, it was second, then we did a rollcall vote where people voted aloud. But we also did have people - I believe - vote by ballot.

6 MAYOR GANIM: I don't know if we did. Well, 7 where's the minutes from - do we have the minutes. 8 from -

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MS. BROWN: They're online.

10 MAYOR GANIM: Well, look it, I'm open to any way 11 the board wants to do it, so - and I don't think 12 there's a particularly right or wrong way. So, I'm at 13 the - I'm at the - I'm assuming to go forward - are you 14 objecting or kind of raising a concern about doing it 15 the way we're doing it, paper ballots? I can't even 16 see who I was talking to.

MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: Well, I don't have an issue
with paper ballots.

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MAYOR GANIM: Okay.

20 MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: I'm just saying that the 21 nominations were seconded, so -

MAYOR GANIM: Okay.

23 MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: - someone said, I want to 24 nominate X, it was seconded, and then a vote continued 25 from there.

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MAYOR GANIM: You want -

2 MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: And as far as paper ballots, that's fine with me. I could have sworn we did a 3 rollcall vote when I looked over the minutes, but -4 5 MAYOR GANIM: I don't - I don't remember that myself. I've always noted differently than some others, 6 7 but, look it, as long as it's not big of how we vote, 8 that's fine. And if there's an issue that somebody 9 wants to discuss, whether you do it a second or not,

10 I'm fine with it.

Do you want to be heard on that?

MR. SOKOLOVIC: Yeah. A second is not required for
any nominations. That's according to Robert's Rules.
It's not written into any statutes or any legalese.
But I don't anticipate it being a problem.

16 MAYOR GANIM: If it becomes a problem, I'll rule 17 on it, and we can go from there. And I think you're 18 right on that.

19 So, with that -

20 MR. SOKOLOVIC: Just one more -

21 MAYOR GANIM: Sure.

22 MR. SOKOLOVIC: And as far as the paper ballots, 23 anything - we can do it verbally, but it's also got to 24 be reduced to writing as per statute.

25 MAYOR GANIM: I think we have a process. I think

1 unless we run into a problem we're not going to unless someone wants to raise an issue whether there's 2 3 a second or not as we go through it, then I'm not going 4 to deal with that issue. But we have paper ballots; we have Team that they can vote on. And that will be the 5 way we proceed. Again, I'll hear anyone else before we 6 7 start because it's - okay, we're good.

8 So, at this point, I'm going to open the floor to 9 nominations. I'll look to my right and to my left and 10 see if I see a hand. Sybil, I see your hand. Would you 11 like to be recognized?

MS. ALLEN: I'd like to nominate Bobbi Brown. 12 13 MAYOR GANIM: Okay. Bobbi Brown's name is in nomination. Is there a second? Do you want to second 14 15 or do you want to make -16 MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: Second. 17 MAYOR GANIM: Does somebody want to make it -18 MR. LOMBARD: Second. 19 MAYOR GANIM: Okay. Just so we clear the air, we 20 have a second. That's fine. MR. BENEJAN: I'd like to - for the record, I'd 21 22 like to nominate Mr. Joe Sokolovic as the chair. 23 MAYOR GANIM: Okay. Does anybody want to second 24 it? 25

MR. SOKOLOVIC: I'll second myself.

MAYOR GANIM: Okay. So, we have no issue on the seconds. We have two names in nomination; we have a process by where we're going to vote. And does anybody else want to make any other nominations for chairperson? I look to my left - left, right, I see no hands, I hear no voices.

7 We'll close nominations, and then it looks like 8 we'll do a vote because we have more than one 9 candidate. So why don't we pass out - let the record 10 reflect that we have a piece of paper being passed out 11 and we'll recognize them as paper ballots that can be 12 filled out by the members.

13 So that's five that are handed out here and we 14 have two members online that won't get paper ballots, 15 is my understanding. I can't see you, so my apologies 16 for sounding impersonal when I talk to you. But you 17 will both vote by Team. If there's any issue with that, 18 we'll address it, but my assumption is we'll make it 19 through this without much problem.

20 MS. BROWN: I think they put it in the message. Do 21 you want them -

22 MR. LOMBARD: They could either e-mail it.

23 MS. BROWN: You guys can - do you have your
24 computer?

25 MR. LOMBARD: More confidential -

2 to you? 3 MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: You want the vote e-mailed? MR. SOKOLOVIC: Point of information. 4 5 MS. BROWN: Yes. MR. SOKOLOVIC: Confidentiality does not matter. 6 7 This vote is public record. 8 MR. LOMBARD: All right. Then they could put it in 9 the chat. MS. BROWN: So, you guys can put it in the chat, 10 11 then, and then you can read it aloud. MAYOR GANIM: If you don't mind, if someone has a 12 concern about that, raise it now. Otherwise, it seems 13 14 to be the simplest way -MS. BAPTISTE-PEREZ: Sam, do you see my vote? I 15 16 already posted it. 17 MS. BROWN: Yeah, Sam sees it. Sam will read 18 them. 19 MAYOR GANIM: Okay. 20 ATTY. ANASTASI: Mayor, the bylaws specifically 21 say the votes will be reduced to writing and made 22 available within 24 hours. 23 MAYOR GANIM: So are you saying we should ask the 24 two members that are online to somehow reduce their 25 vote to writing.

MS. BROWN: Yeah. Do you want them to e-mail it

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MS. BROWN: E-mail.

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ATTY. ANASTASI: Yes, they should e-mail it
 somehow and make it available.

MAYOR GANIM: All right. So why don't we just close that loop. Even though we may have the votes - you don't have your e-mail, but they could also e-mail it to you. This way you have it, so we close the loop on having - what is it, seven votes? - in writing. Do they have your e-mail? Do you have -

MR. MACCARONE: I - I don't - what is - what is the e-mail address?

12 MS. BROWN: So, guys -

13 MR. BENEJAN: Ms. Santos, Ms. Santos.

MS. BROWN: Yeah. So, you guys are going to send - you guys can put your ballot inside of the Teams for now, but within 24 hours it needs to be e-mailed to Ms. Arlene. And her e-mail is in - so Christine has already sent. So, Mr. Maccarone, you just need to send yours. And you're going to send it to Ms. Arlene.

20 MR. MACCARONE: Okay. So -

21 MS. BROWN: No, no. No, his - the -

22 MR. BENEJAN: E-mail.

23 MS. BROWN: Yeah, the printed out. Right now, -

24 MR. MACCARONE: So - so -

25 MS. BROWN: All right Mr. - Mr. Maccarone, you can

1 put it in Teams.

2 MR. MACCARONE: Okay. So how do I put it in Teams? 3 I'm sorry.

MS. BROWN: Are you on your phone?

MR. MACCARONE: Yup, I'm on my phone.

6 MS. BROWN: So, we're in the new age of - well, 7 we're going to read the votes aloud. We'll read them 8 aloud, so -

9 MAYOR GANIM: Yeah, if you don't have a problem 10 with that, I mean, as long as we get everyone's intent 11 out and - and there's no confusion about that and 12 there's no confusion over the vote, then I'm satisfied 13 with it, and we will acknowledge the city attorney's 14 requirement that at some point it be put in writing. I 15 don't know what means.

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MR. MACCARONE: Okay.

MAYOR GANIM: It could be an e-mail, it could be in - in the minutes, but I want to - we want to respect the process in case someone wants to -

MS. BROWN: Correct.

MAYOR GANIM: - question it later on for whatever
 reasons. So, she's counting the paper votes, right?
 MR. LOMBARD: Mike -

MS. BROWN: Mike's going to say his because hedoesn't know how to put it in.

1 MAYOR GANIM: The only difference, Mike, so that we're very clear, is that all the other ballots are -2 3 their names are not attached to it - as long as you don't have a problem with that. I want to treat 4 5 everybody who votes the same way. But as long as you don't have a problem with that - and I'm not suggesting 6 7 you should - do you have six there? I mean, five plus 8 one on - in chat? 9 MS. BROWN: Yes. 10 MAYOR GANIM: Yes? Okay. So, we have - we have 11 one left to vote? 12 MS. BROWN: No, he's going to say his verbally because he doesn't know how to do it. 13 MAYOR GANIM: Go ahead, would you like to vote 14 15 verbally? 16 MR. MACCARONE: Are you talk - are you talking to 17 me? 18 MAYOR GANIM: Yeah, I apologize. I apologize, the 19 difficulty -20 MR. MACCARONE: Okay. My vote - Mr. Mayor -MAYOR GANIM: Yes, please, Mike. 21 22 MR. MACCARONE: - my vote is for Bobbi Brown. 23 MAYOR GANIM: Okay. So, one vote for Bobbi Brown. 24 And we have six votes remaining. 25 MS. BROWN: Say the person's name and the vote.

1 Yeah.

MS. SANTOS-DEJESUS: Okay. For Bobbi Brown, I have Bobbi Brown; one vote. Sybil Allen: Bobbi Brown; two. Joseph Lombard: Bobbi Brown; that will be three. Christine Baptiste-Perez: Bobbi Brown; that will be four. Michael Maccarone: Bobbi Brown; that would be five. Joseph Sokolovic: Joseph Sokolovic; one. Albert Benejan: Joseph Sokolovic; two.

9 MAYOR GANIM: Okay. Unless someone else - we'll 10 just take a pause, not that we need to say anything, 11 but if anybody wants to say anything at this point, the 12 votes appear to be accurate; they've been read; they've 13 been written; they've been sent it. One's verbal, which 14 will be closed the loop on. And I would say that the 15 votes show Bobbi Brown is the new chairperson for the Board of Education. A round of applause. Applause for 16 17 this difficult job. It's nice to get them. You know, 18 the best - challenging, but you have a great board and 19 I know your experience will serve you well.

20 The question I have for you now is, do want the 21 experience of handling the vice chair, and - what's the 22 third officer we have? The -

23 MS. BROWN: Secretary.

24 MAYOR GANIM: And the secretary.

25 MS. BROWN: Yes.

MAYOR GANIM: And then I will go to - I'll tell you what. We'll go - there's a memorial for Yvette Brantley and for John Olson, both in the 132nd District of the West Side with a tree lighting, so I will beg your indulgence if you do take over at this point. And two council members who served the city well who are being remembered today there.

8 So, do you need me for anything further?

9 MS. BROWN: No.

10 MAYOR GANIM: Anyone?

11 MS. BROWN: You're all set.

MAYOR GANIM: Does the city attorney need me for anything further? Any members of the board? Any members of the public?

Other than I can say is, I guess from all of us, 15 as we enter the holiday seasons, I wish everyone safe 16 17 and happy holidays, through this board, through the 18 city administration, through the - all of us, we look 19 forward to making and working hard and making the best 20 as we enter the new year for all of our residents, 21 students - everyone who is involved in the city of 22 Bridgeport.

23 One thing, a point of personal privilege. I never 24 get to hit one of these. Can I just hit it a couple of 25 times?

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MS. BROWN: Sure, Mr. Mayor.

2 MAYOR GANIM: All right. Thank you. Thank you. 3 MR. MACCARONE: Thank you, Mayor. MS. BROWN: All right. So, we're going to move on 4 5 to vice chairman. I'm going to open up the floor for 6 vice chairman. 7 MR. LOMBARD: I'd like to nominate Christine 8 Baptiste-Perez. 9 MS. BROWN: We have one. Is there a second? 10 MR. MACCARONE: I second. 11 MS. BROWN: All right. Is there another 12 nomination for vice chair? Is there another nomination for vice chair? One more time. Is there a nomination 13 14 for vice chair? 15 Hearing none, I don't believe we need to vote on it because - yes? Okay. Yes, we do need to vote on 16 17 it. 18 All right. So, we'll do paper ballots again for 19 the record, and then we'll just read it aloud. And 20 we'll just have you read them aloud. 21 (There was a delay.) MS. BROWN: We'll start by - Mr. Maccarone, feel 22 23 free to say your vote over the - out loud for the 24 record, and then we'll have -25 MR. MACCARONE: Okay.

MS. BROWN: - and then we'll have Ms. - go ahead.
 MR. MACCARONE: Okay. I vote for Ms. Christine
 Baptiste-Perez.

MS. BROWN: All right. Ms. - ready when you are.
Go ahead.

6 MS. SANTOS-DEJESUS: For vice chairman, I have 7 Albert Benejan voted Christine Baptiste-Perez. Joseph 8 Sokolovic: Christine Baptiste-Perez. Joseph Lombard: 9 Christine Baptiste-Perez. Bobbi Brown: Christine 10 Baptiste-Perez. Sybil Allen: Christine Baptiste-Perez. 11 Michael Maccarone: Christine Baptiste-Perez. And 12 Christine Baptiste-Perez is Christine Baptiste-Perez.

MS. BROWN: Thank you. Let the record reflect, Ms.
Christine, congratulations.

MR. MACCARONE: It's great. Very good.

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MS. BROWN: All right. Our next one is secretary nominations. I'll open up the floor for nominations for secretary.

19MR. SOKOLOVIC: I'd like to nominate Albert Benejan20for secretary.

MS. BROWN: I'd like to nominate Mr. Lombard,
Joseph Lombard. Oh, wait, do we want a second? Sorry,
I know we were doing it.

24 MR. SOKOLOVIC: A second is not required.
25 ATTY. ANASTASI: Seconds are not required.

1 MS. BROWN: Okay. We were just - okay. Is there 2 any - is there any other nominations? Are there any 3 other nominations? One more time. Are there any other nominations? 4 So, we have two candidates; we have Albert Benejan 5 and Mr. Joseph Lombard. We can start the ballot 6 7 process. 8 (There was a delay.) 9 MS. BROWN: Whenever you're ready. All right. We're going to - Mr. Maccarone, feel free to start off 10 11 by sharing who did you nominate - I mean, who did you 12 vote for. MR. MACCARONE: I would - I would vote for Joe 13 14 Lombard. 15 MS. BROWN: Okay. All right. And now Ms. Santos. 16 MS. SANTOS-DEJESUS: I have Christine Baptiste-17 Perez: Joseph Lombard. Joseph Sokolovic: Albert 18 Benejan. Albert Benejan voted for Albert Benejan. 19 Joseph Lombard voted for Joseph Lombard. Bobbi Brown: 20 Mr. Lombard. Sybil Allen: Joseph Lombard. 21 MS. BROWN: Okay. Tabulations, Mr. Lombard. All 22 right. 23 MR. MACCARONE: Very good. 24 MS. BROWN: This process concludes the election of 25 officers. Officers will - you know, to their positions.

1 At this moment, we're going to have - I'll 2 entertain a motion for approval of 2021 organizational meeting minutes. Is there a motion to approve? 3 MR. BENEJAN: So moved. 4 5 MS. BROWN: Moved by Mr. Benejan. Is there a 6 second? 7 MS. ALLEN: Second. 8 MS. BROWN: Second by Ms. Allen. All in favor? 9 ("Ayes" were sounded.) 10 MS. BROWN: Any opposed? Any abstentions? 11 Meeting minutes have been approved. 12 All right. Now I would like to entertain a motion 13 to adjourn the meeting. 14 MR. BENEJAN: So moved. 15 MS. BROWN: Motion by Mr. Benejan. Is there a 16 second? 17 MR. SOKOLOVIC: Second. 18 MS. ALLEN: Second. 19 MS. BROWN: Second by Ms. Allen. All in favor? 20 ("Ayes" were sounded.) 21 MS. BROWN: Any opposed? Any abstentions? Hearing 22 none, have a good night, everyone. We'll see you 23 tomorrow for our regular board meeting. Special 24 meeting; that is our regular meeting. Goodnight, 25 everyone.
